

When it comes to gold medals, it's all about the numbers! Which athlete can run the fastest? Which can jump or **soar** the farthest in the ski jump? When the numbers are right, they can add up to a gold medal.

What do gold medal numbers look like? Sometimes they look pretty small. For runners, smaller numbers are better. Even a part of a second can make a difference. In 1992, Mike Maarsh won a gold medal in the 200-meter race. It took him only 20.01 seconds to finish. The next closest time was 20.13 seconds. That's only a little bit slower.

Sometimes bigger numbers are better. Bob Beamon broke the world record in the long jump in 1968. He jumped 29.2 feet (8.9 m). That beat the record of 27.339 feet (8.35m) by almost 2 feet (0.6m).

For the ski jump, farther is better. In 2002, Simon Ammann jumped 436 feet (133m) in the air. That flight was enough for a gold medal. But he could not hold his landing. He fell back onto his skis. That put him in fourth place.

Gold medal numbers may be big or small. Either way, they can show us the winners.
