People once watched the sun, the moon, and the stars to help them tell time. They watched the sun rise and set. That unit of time is called a day. People watched the four seasons repeat. That unit of time is called a year.

The seasons were very important to their lives. They had to know when to plant crops or to prepare for winter. They made calendars to help them track the seasons.

The first calendars divided the year by cycles of the moon. People noticed that the moon changed shape over time. They saw that there were about 12 full moons from one spring to the next. They learned that 29 or 30 days passed between each full moon. They divide the year into 12 lunar months. Twelve lunar months equaled about 354 days. That made each year in their calendar 354 days long.

Calendars based on the moon did not work well. Over time, they no longer matched the seasons. Every eight years, three months had to be added.

The Egyptians noticed that the Dog Star rose next to the sun every 365 days. They began to use a solar calendar, one based on the sun. This calendar worked much better. Today's calendars are based on those early Egyptian calendars.
