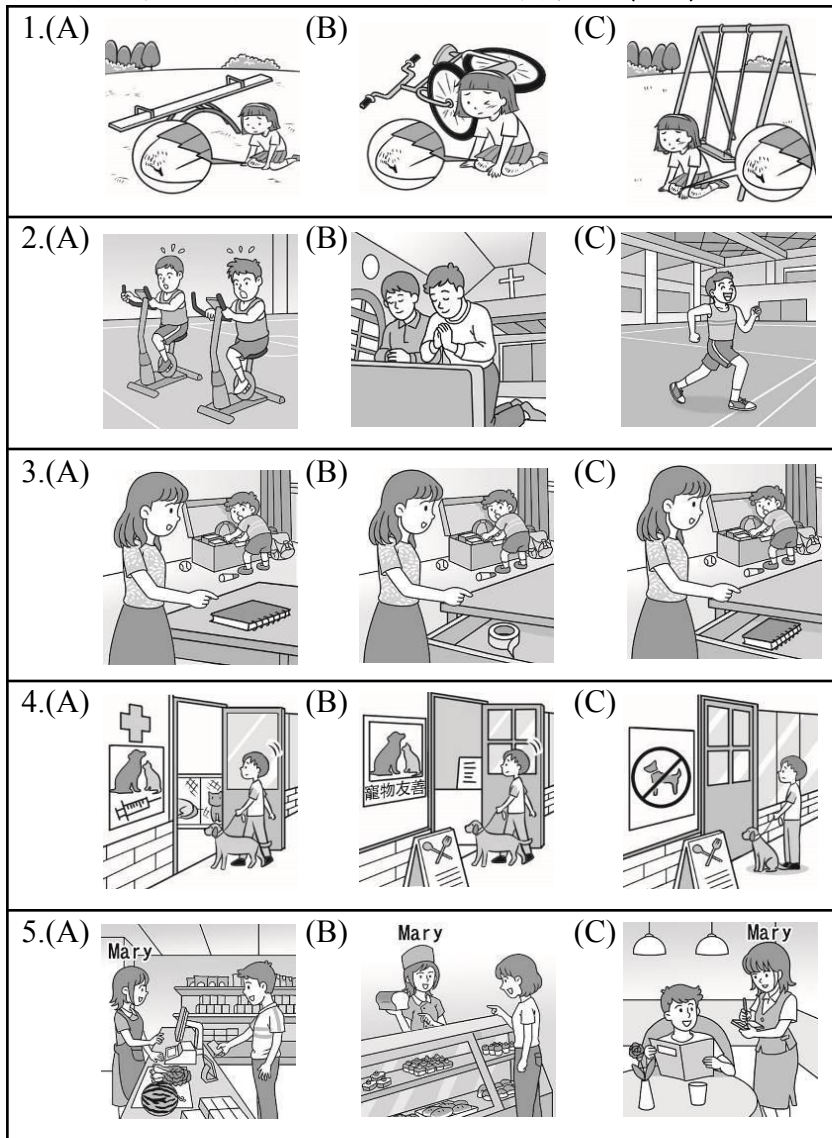

The animal is a Seychelles giant turtle called Jonathan. Zoologists believe he was born in 1832, but there are no official records of his birth. Some scientists think Jonathan might actually be ten years older. He could be as old as 200. Jonathan was born in the Seychelles. He was taken to the British overseas territory of St Helena in the South Atlantic Ocean in 1882 as a gift for the St Helena governor.

Jonathan's vets said he had a good birthday. There was a three-day party for him. Chefs made him a special tortoise birthday cake that was full of his favorite vegetables. St Helena also printed a set of special stamps to celebrate his birthday. Unfortunately, Jonathan did not get to see any of the celebrations because he is blind. He also cannot smell. However, he has an excellent sense of hearing, so he could hear "Happy Birthday" being sung. Jonathan's vet, Joe Hollins, said the giant tortoise still has plenty of energy. He also likes to relax in the sun. He said: "On mild days, he will sunbathe – his long neck and legs stretched fully out of his shell."

Candles

People light candles at Hanukkah. They light one candle every evening. The special Hanukkah candle holder is called a Hanukkah **menorah**. It has nine candles.

Food

People make special pancakes at this time of year. The pancakes are made with potatoes, onions, eggs, flour and oil. People also eat delicious jam doughnuts.

Families and friends give each other presents and money at Hanukkah. Children sometimes get chocolate coins. People also give cards that often have pictures of a menorah or a dreidel.

Oxford English Dictionary (OED) often adds new words to the book. Some of these new words are created when two words are put together. One example of this is “voluntourism,” which is made up of “volunteer” and “tourism.” It means you work as a volunteer when you are on a trip. In other words, it is not just to have a vacation. Instead, it is a chance for volunteers to use their skills and interests to help others in need. This has been popular for almost half of a century, and it was finally added to the dictionary in 2014.

On the other hand, “staycation” was added to OED in 2010 after it became widely popular in the late 2000s. The earliest use of the word was back in 2003 when a reporter combined “**A**” and “**B**” together. People or families usually stay home and enjoy activities or plan a day trip around their house during their staycation. From swimming in the backyard, visiting a museum, to going to local festivals, these help create the feeling of a vacation without going abroad. After COVID-19 hit the world in 2020, people were not sure if the place they visited was safe. Therefore, the idea of staycation was brought back again.

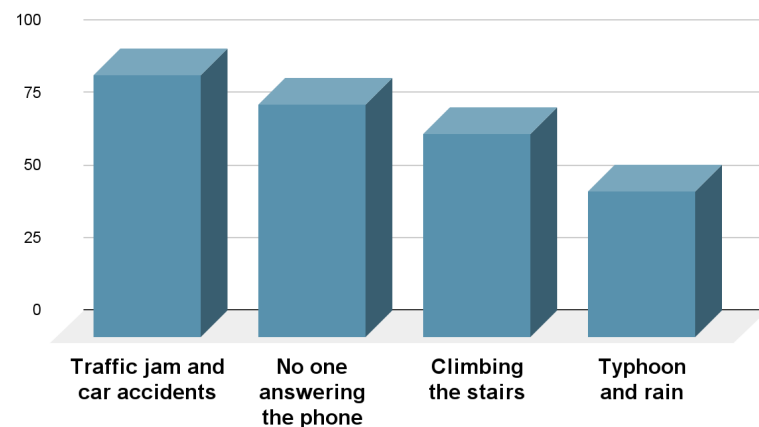
