Have you ever heard of cyberbullying? It is harming or harassing others online. With the increased use of communication technology, cyberbullying has become common, especially among teenagers. They may send mean text messages or emails, spread rumors on social networking websites, and post embarrassing pictures or video clips. Cyberbullying can happen any time and hurt a student even when he or she is alone. Sometimes these mean messages or images are anonymous. It is difficult to know where they are from.

Students being cyberbullied will feel upset. What's more, it may cause serious problems, such as being unwilling to go to school, having low self-confidence, or committing suicide. If you are harassed online, it is important not to respond because that will make the situation worse. Instead, you can keep the evidence and ask your teachers or parents for help. Don't be afraid to stand up for yourself or your friends. These behaviors usually stop quickly when someone speaks up. Now, being online is part of your life. Remember to treat people the way you like to be treated and to protect yourself during online communication.
