





The Icehotel is in the village of Jukkasjärvi, Sweden. Some parts of the hotel are made from thousands of tons of ice and snow which are taken from the nature. These parts melt in summer and must be rebuilt every winter. In November, building starts all over again to have the hotel ready to open in December. Artists are invited to create different rooms and decorations made by ice, so each room is special and different from the previous years.
