















Earthquake is one of many destructive, natural disasters. Luckily, some earthquakes happen in the deep sea. However, others shake the big cities with no goodness. Although we are better able to tell before they happen today, earthquakes still destroy many houses and kill lots of people. The Los Angeles earthquake in 1994 was the most destructive in U.S. history. Not only did many people die, but people also had great loss in dollars. Sometimes tsunami, a very big wave, came after the earthquake from the sea. In September 2018, a tsunami caused by a big earthquake killed at least 1,530 people. About 2,550 people were known to get hurt from the event. However, it was not the worst tsunami in history. On December 26, 2004, a terrible earthquake happened in the southern Asia and caused a deadly tsunami. It was reported that almost 290 thousand people died and many others became homeless. It is the world's deadliest natural disaster since the 1976 earthquake in China.

Most people make about two kilograms of waste (trash) every day, and about 7% of this waste is made up of plastic products that can be recycled. Today, plastic can be recycled into products like picnic tables, park benches, and even high-chairs.

First, plastic is collected and taken to a recycling center, where it is sorted out. When plastic is sorted out, symbols have to be printed on every recyclable plastic product used. There are two kinds of plastic that we usually use: *high density polyethylene* (HDPE), and *low density polyethylene* (LDPE). HDPE plastic is usually used to make furniture, and LDPE plastic are usually for things like milk bottles and shopping bags.

Both plastics need to be ground into powder and washed with hot water and detergent. Mud and other things, like labels, are taken off. After the wash, the powder is dried with hot air.

Sometimes, the powder is sold. But other times, the powder is heated, colored, and then put into a machine. The machine makes the powder into pellets which are bought by a company that shapes pellets into pieces of plastic "wood". This plastic wood is used to make flowerpots, trash cans, picnic tables, benches, toys, mats, and many other things.
